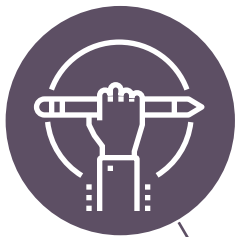


KEYS TO ADVANCING YOUR STUDENT WORK-READINESS PROGRAM
